

Art Deco Museum - Children's Program

This program is intended to educate children K-12 about the History of Miami Beach, Art Deco architecture, and continuing preservation efforts through walking tours, videos, and other activities. Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance and are only available for groups.

School Program (2 hours):

- Tour on Ocean Drive and Ocean Rescue Headquarters
- Brief tour of the Art Deco Museum
- Watch short video in the Art Deco Museum
- Discussion of the history of Art Deco in Miami Beach and what is Art Deco?
- Answer questionnaire "What did I learn today?"
- Answer anonymous survey about the Art Deco Museum and what could be improved.

Tours can only be scheduled for Tuesdays and Thursdays during normal operating hours (10am - 5pm)

The Art Deco Museum does not have a cafeteria facilities for school groups. Please plan to have lunch at school or nearby in Lummus Park before or after your visit to the museum.

Buses must drop students off at the front entrance to the Art Deco Welcome Center at 1001 Ocean Drive. Parking is not provided for buses.
